School Resources for Students in Temporary Housing



ENROLLMENT

<u>Family Welcome Centers</u> help with enrollment and school transfers. Students in temporary housing can enroll in school even if they don't have the documents normally needed (including proof of address, birth certificate, and immunization records).



METROCARDS

Parents in temporary housing can get free MetroCards if their child is not bused to school. Ask for a parent MetroCard at your child's school.



BUSING INFORMATION

Parents can get school bus route info by signing in to NYC Schools Account (NYCSA), calling 311, or by emailing BusingExceptions@schools.nyc.gov. For students in temporary **doubled-up** situations who need busing, visit the NYCPS Support Hub and Create A Ticket online or ask your child's school to Create A Ticket for you.



NYC SCHOOLS ACCOUNT (NYCSA)

An online hub for schedules, attendance, busing, report cards, special education services, and more! Learn about how to create an account and sign in at SchoolsAccount.nyc (NYCSA). To get a creation code for a student, ask the Parent Coordinator at your child's school or the Students in Temporary Housing (STH) Regional Manager.



SHELTER TRANSFERS

Parents can request a shelter transfer to be closer to their children's school. Families will be transferred if there is an appropriate unit available. To request a transfer, contact the case manager or shelter director. For more information, email Project LIT at projectlit@advocatesforchildren.org.
