ene Ludwig is a business leader and expert on banking regulation, risk management, and fiscal policy who founded Promontory Financial Group in 2001.

As a former federal regulator and banker, Mr. Ludwig is thoroughly attuned to the issues involved in revamping the regulatory framework to withstand future shocks. Under his leadership, Promontory has become synonymous with excellence in compliance and risk management, and is renowned for its ability to help financial companies resolve their most pressing challenges. Promontory was acquired by IBM in 2016, combining Promontory's domain expertise with IBM's advanced technology.

Before founding Promontory, Mr. Ludwig was vice chairman and senior control officer of Bankers Trust New York Corp. He was instrumental in steering the firm through its landmark merger with Deutsche Bank.

As U.S. comptroller of the currency from 1993 to 1998, Gene served as the Clinton administration's point person on the policy response to the credit crunch of the early 1990s. Under his purview, lending to low and moderate income Americans increased tenfold, as did national bank investments in community development corporations.

Before becoming comptroller, Mr. Ludwig was a partner in the law firm of Covington & Burling, specializing in banking law.

Mr. Ludwig was raised in York, Pennsylvania. He graduated magna cum laude from Haverford College and received a scholarship to Oxford University, where he earned a Master of Arts degree as a Keasbey Fellow. He holds a Juris Doctor from Yale University, where he was editor of the Yale Law Journal and chairman of Yale Legislative Services.

During his more than 25 years with Morgan Stanley, Mr. Kelleher has worked in the United States, Europe and Asia Pacific and has extensive capital markets and securities markets experience.

Mr. Kelleher serves on the Chairman's Council of Student Sponsor Partners, which has provided scholarships and mentoring to hundreds of low-income New York City

students striving to secure a quality education. Additionally, Mr. Kelleher led Morgan Stanley's partnership with The Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children in London, to build The Morgan Stanley Clinical Building, a state-of-the-art medical facility (2012), and The Morgan Stanley House, to provide accommodations for the parents of hospitalized children (2015).

Colm Kelleher graduated with an

M.A. degree in History from Oxford University where he is an Honorary Fellow of Oriel College. He is also a Fellow of the Institute of Chartered Accountants, serves on the Board of Americans for Oxford, and is a member of Oxford Vice-Chancellor's Circle, TheCity UK Advisory Council and the British Museum Advisory Board. Mr. Kelleher is an Irish citizen, and with his wife, Ella, has three grown children and resides in New York.

ynthia McFadden is the senior legal and investigative correspondent for NBC News.

Her reporting appears across all platforms of NBC News and MSNBC, including NBC Nightly News with Lester Holt, TODAY, Meet the Press, Dateline, and NBCNews.com.

Since joining *NBC News* in 2014, Ms. McFadden has covered a range of stories across the United States and around the globe, scoring exclusive interviews with Amal Clooney and the hacker known as Guccifer.

Ms. McFadden's reporting has also helped lead to the release of the president of the Maldives from political imprisonment and to the commutation of Chelsea Manning's sentence by President Obama. Most recently, Ms. McFadden and the *NBC News* Investigative Unit have broken dozens of national security stories relating to terrorism, Yemen, and Russian involvement in the 2016 U.S. Presidential election.

Prior to joining *NBC News*, Ms. McFadden spent twenty years at *ABC News* as a highly respected anchor and correspondent known for her diverse portfolio of powerful investigations. For ten years, she served as a correspondent for the network's late-night news broadcast, *Nightline*.

Her distinguished work has won many of broadcasting's most coveted prizes, including Emmy, Peabody, duPont, Sigma Delta Chi, and Foreign Press awards.

A native of Maine, Ms. McFadden graduated Phi Beta Kappa and summa cum laude from Bowdoin College, and received her law degree from Columbia University.

ulian is a high school junior on the autism spectrum. His parents contacted AFC when Julian was 9 years old because the New York City Department of Education (DOE) had placed him in a school where he was failing to make progress academically. When his case came to us, Julian was incorrectly labeled as speech and language impaired with a borderline IQ, although private testing indicated that he was functioning at a much higher level. The special education program he was in was meeting neither his needs nor the mandates of his Individualized Education Program. His parents were concerned that Julian, who was in the third grade, was being given firstgrade course work, while at the same time being pressured to take standardized tests on material he had never been taught. Moreover, the environment was chaotic and stressful, making it nearly impossible for him to learn.

AFC successfully argued for the DOE to fund Julian's matriculation at Learning Spring, a private elementary school program with specialization in meeting the needs of

students on the autism spectrum. At Learning Spring, Julian began to show real progress; the program was more academically challenging, and he was making connections with his classmates

and teachers. Two years later, AFC secured the cost of Julian's tuition to attend Gersh Academy, a private school for students on the autism spectrum, where he attended middle and high school. During his sophomore year, AFC and Julian's parents advocated for him to transition to Gersh's more challenging I Am I Can Program, where he has successfully completed all but one of his Regents exams. Julian expects to graduate next year with a Regents diploma and hopes to pursue his many interests.

Our efforts on the individual and policy levels inform and strengthen each other, further increasing our effectiveness for the communities we serve.

FOR OVER FOUR DECADES ADVOCATES FOR CHILDREN OF NEW YORK HAS MADE COUNTLESS FUTURES BRIGHTER

By Solving Problems for Parents in Need:

Any parent of a New York City public school student knows how difficult it can be to navigate a school system that has 1.1 million children. Our Jill Chaifetz Education Helpline is a crucial resource for New York families having problems with special education, transportation, school suspensions, transfers, and more. Our experienced lawyers and advocates work with parents to get their children the educational support they need in school.

By Sharing Our Unique Expertise in Education Advocacy:

We know that one of the best ways to reach the most isolated students is to collaborate with other organizations that serve them. AFC is currently partnering with twenty organizations funded by the Robin Hood Foundation in areas like child welfare, juvenile justice, and domestic violence. In addition, AFC's highly skilled staff can be found in foster care agencies and community-based organizations across the five boroughs, sharing their expertise in educational advocacy, providing legal representation

to families, and helping these partners build their capacity to advocate for the educational needs of the children they serve.

By Understanding and Addressing the Education-Related Challenges Confronting the City's Most Vulnerable Children:

AFC proudly serves on the frontlines of the fight to champion the education-related rights of children and youth who are most likely to experience failure or discrimination in school because of factors beyond their control.



CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

AFC's multi-pronged approach is a model for education advocacy throughout the city and state. First, we provide one-on-one legal representation and advocacy to help lowincome families of children with disabilities get the educational services and support they need. Second, we offer free workshops throughout the city to bring training, information, and direct assistance on the education system to parents and the professionals who work with them. Third, we address

systemic problems with the education of students with disabilities through our policy work and when necessary, federal litigation. And finally, we coordinate and lead a collaborative effort called the ARISE Coalition, which brings together more than sixty different organizations and individuals to press for policy change to benefit children with disabilities in the New York City schools.



IMMIGRANT STUDENTS & ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

AFC's bilingual project staff advocates on behalf of individual parents and their children, trains parents and community-based organizations serving immigrant families on education-related rights, monitors access to interpreters and translated materials in the city's schools, and collaborates with other groups to support communities seeking to improve outcomes for immigrants and English Language Learners.

EARLY CHILDHOOD

AFC's Early Childhood Education Project provides individual case assistance, community education, and policy advocacy to improve access to early childhood education for low-income children, ages 0-5, so that children can enter kindergarten prepared to succeed.

CHILDREN IN THE CHILD WELFARE SYSTEM

AFC's Project Achieve advocates for the educational needs of children in or at risk of placement in foster care while building capacity in the agencies that serve them. Project staff operates satellite offices in child welfare agencies, providing on-site assistance and training to caseworkers, birth parents, and foster parents so that they can address the

education-related issues affecting their children. Project staff also conducts policy advocacy on the city and state levels to improve educational outcomes for students in foster care.

STUDENTS FACING DISCIPLINARY ISSUES & COURT-INVOLVED YOUTH

AFCs School Justice Project (SJP) provides case advocacy and legal representation to address the educational needs of youth facing school suspension or court involvement. Through relationships built with social services agencies, community-based organizations, and community courts, project staff are able to reach the students who often fall through the

cracks. The project also provides trainings and technical assistance to parents, young people, and the professionals who work with them. Finally, project staff advocate for systemic reform with respect to school discipline and school climate, as well as the education of court-involved youth.

STUDENTS IN TEMPORARY HOUSING

AFC operates the New York State Technical and Education Assistance Center for Homeless Students (NYS-TEACHS), which focuses on building the capacity of school districts throughout the state to improve educational opportunities for homeless children and youth.
