ne of New York's most recognized forecasters, Janice Huff is the chief meteorologist for weekday NBC 4 New York, delivering weather reports for News 4 New York's four evening newscasts.

Ms. Huff is also a host of Wednesday's Child, a feature on adoption that airs weekly during News 4 New York and Weekend Today in New York. A passionate advocate for children and community-related issues, Ms. Huff has received numerous accolades for her reporting on Wednesday's Child. Ms. Huff also works with New York City Court-Appointed Special Advocates, "CASA-NYC," to help protect the needs and well-being of children in foster care, making sure that they are placed in safe permanent homes. Among the organizations that have recognized Ms. Huff's commitment to improving the lives of children are: the 199SEIU/Employer Child Care Corporation (2011 Annual Care for Kids Gala); Family Focus Adoption Services (2011 Gala); The Miracle Makers Media Award (2004); and the Second Annual Nicholas Scoppetta Award for Service to Children.

Ms. Huff has also been honored by McDonald's (2011 Black Media Legends Award recognizing Ms. Huff as one of 24 esteemed Black Media Legends); the YWCA of New York City (2008 "W" award); the New York Chapter of The National Black Journalist Association (2007 Community Service Award); the New York City Chapter of American Women in Radio & Television (2006 Golden Apple Award); the Federation of Protestant Welfare Agencies (2006 Laura Parsons Pratt Award); and The Administration for Children's Services (2004 Golden Heart Award).

Ms. Huff is a member of the National Weather Association, The American Meteorological Society, the National Association of Black Journalists, the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences, and the Friars Club. A native of Manhattan, Janice Huff graduated from Florida State University at Tallahassee, where she majored in Meteorology. She is married and resides in New Jersey.

Mr. Ferguson is a fellow of the American Academy of Arts & Sciences and serves on the boards of International Flavors & Fragrances Inc., The Conference Board, the American Council of Life Insurers, the Institute for Advanced Study, and Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. He is also a member of the advisory board of

Brevan Howard Asset Management LLP. Mr. Ferguson is chairman of the Business-Higher Education Forum and a member of the Economic Club of New York, the Council on Foreign Relations, and the Group of Thirty.

Mr. Ferguson serves on the Congressional Budget Office's Panel of Economic Advisers and was a member of President Obama's Council on Jobs and Competitiveness. He holds a B.A., J.D., and Ph.D. in economics, all from Harvard University.

sha and Ayanna are twin sisters who will graduate from Bay Ridge Preparatory High School in June. The sisters began

receiving special education services in second grade when their mother, Bweela Steptoe, became concerned about their

academic progress. At first, Ms. Steptoe was told that her daughters would "grow out of it." However, by 5th grade, they had fallen so far behind that their promotion was in doubt.

Knowing she could no longer "wait and see," Ms. Steptoe contacted AFC, and together we worked quickly to find the girls 6th grade placements at The

Sterling School, where their unique learning needs would be met. AFC then filed for and won an impartial hearing requiring the Department of Education to pay their tuition. Once at Sterling, for the first time in years, Asha and Ayanna made academic gains and wanted to attend school. When they needed a new program for 7th grade, AFC won tuition for Bay Ridge Prep's (BRP's) Bridge program.

For each of the past six years, AFC, with the help of pro bono attorneys Elizabeth Callahan, Meridith Krell and several pro bono partners before them, has represented the family and gone to hearing on one or both of the cases to make certain the girls received the curriculum and support they needed to be successful in school.

While at Bay Ridge Prep, the sisters have grown academically and socially, developing their talents as visual artists and joining after-school clubs. They even created an Anime Club! And that hard work has paid off. Asha and Ayanna passed all five of

the State's required Regents exams and are graduating with Regents diplomas with bright futures ahead of them! Asha, whose interest in cooking started in BRP's after-school program, will attend the culinary program at Johnson and Wales University, while Ayanna, a manga artist, will pursue her love of anime in the sequential art program at Savannah College of Art and Design. AFC has selected Asha and Ayanna to receive its 2015 Education Champion Awards in recognition of all of their hard work and perseverance to receive an appropriate education.

No other city-wide organization is like AFC: working in the trenches to provide these vulnerable students and their families with urgently needed guidance and advocacy, while at the same time, pressing for systemic reforms that benefit all students, even those who are most challenging to educate. Our efforts on the individual and policy levels inform and strengthen each other, further increasing our effectiveness for the communities we serve.

For over four decades AFC has made COUNTLESS FUTURES BRIGHTER

By Solving Problems for Parents in Need:

Any parent of a New York City public school student knows how difficult it can be to navigate a school system that has 1.1 million children. Our Jill Chaifetz Education Helpline is a crucial resource for New York families having problems with special education, transportation, school suspensions, transfers, and more. Our experienced lawyers

and advocates work with parents to get their children the educational support they need in school.

By Sharing Our Unique Expertise in Education Advocacy:

We know that one of the best ways to reach the most isolated students is to collaborate with other organizations that serve them. AFC is currently partnering with twenty-one organizations funded by the Robin Hood Foundation in areas like child welfare, juvenile justice, and domestic vio-



lence. In addition, AFC's highly skilled staff can be found in foster care agencies and community-based organizations across the five boroughs, sharing their expertise in educational advocacy, providing legal representation to families, and helping these partners build their capacity to advocate for the educational needs of the children they serve.

ADVOCATES FOR CHILDREN AT A GLANCE

By Understanding and Addressing the Education-Related Challenges Confronting the City's Most Vulnerable Children:

AFC proudly serves on the frontlines of the fight to champion the education-related rights of children and youth who are most likely to experience failure or discrimination in school because of factors beyond their control.

CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

AFC's multi-pronged approach is a model for education advocacy throughout the city and state. First, we provide one-on-one legal representation and advocacy to help low-income families of children with disabilities get the educational services and support they need. Second, we offer free workshops throughout the city to bring training, information, and direct assistance on the education system to parents and the professionals who work with them. Third, we address systemic problems with the education of students with disabilities through our policy work and when

necessary, federal litigation. And finally, we coordinate and lead a collaborative effort called the ARISE Coalition, which brings together more than fifty different organizations and individuals to press for policy change to benefit children with disabilities in the New York City schools.

IMMIGRANT STUDENTS & ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

AFC's bilingual project staff advocates on behalf of individual parents and their children, trains parents and communitybased organizations serving immigrant families on educationrelated rights, monitors access to interpreters and translated materials in the city's schools, and collaborates with other groups to support communities seeking to improve outcomes for immigrants and English Language Learners.

EARLY CHILDHOOD

AFC's Early Childhood Education Project provides individual case assistance, community education, and policy advocacy to improve access to early childhood education for low-income children, ages 0-5, so that children can enter kindergarten prepared to succeed.

ADVOCATES FOR CHILDREN AT A GLANCE

CHILDREN IN THE CHILD WELFARE SYSTEM

AFC's Project Achieve advocates for the educational needs of children in or at risk of placement in foster care while building capacity in the agencies that serve them. Project staff operates satellite offices in child welfare agencies, providing on-site assistance and training to caseworkers, birth parents, and foster parents so that they can address the education-related issues affecting their children. Project staff also conducts policy advocacy on the city and state levels to improve educational outcomes for students in foster care.

STUDENTS FACING DISCIPLINARY ISSUES & COURT-INVOLVED YOUTH

AFC's School Justice Project (SJP) provides case advocacy and legal representation to address the educational needs of youth facing school suspension or court involvement. Through relationships built with social services agencies, community-based organizations, and community courts, project staff are able to reach the students who often fall



through the cracks. The Project also provides trainings and technical assistance to parents, young people, and the professionals who work with them. Finally, project staff advocate for systemic reform with respect to school discipline and school climate, as well as the education of court-involved youth.

STUDENTS IN TEMPORARY HOUSING

AFC operates the New York State Technical and Education Assistance Center for Homeless Students (NYS-TEACHS), which focuses on building the capacity of school districts throughout the state to improve educational opportunities for homeless children and youth.
